


I made an appearance on AVA TV - Channel 57 to take calls from viewers who had questions regarding services our offices provide. Thank you for all your calls and questions.

JULY IN O.C. HISTORY




Orange County's recorded history began on July 22, 1769 with the arrival of Gaspar de Portola's exploratory expedition at our southern border. Friars baptized two native children that day in Christianitos Canyon – the first baptism in California.

July 1, 1943	Tech. Sgt. William Durkin, of MCAS EI Toro, rescued tycoon inventor and aviator Howard Hughes from the wreckage of an experimental plane south of Santa Ana.	
July 4, 1904	The first Pacific Electric Railway "Red Car" arrived in Orange County with the opening of the Huntington Beach line opened. A big Independence Day parade welcomed the Red Cars – a Huntington Beach tradition that continues today.	
July 19, 1990	Presidents Bush, Reagan, Ford and Nixon attended the dedication of the Richard Nixon Library and Birthplace in Yorba Linda, which opened to the public the following day.	
July 24, 1956	Cypress was incorporated under the name Dairy City.
