A RECORD NUMBER OF COUPLES FOUND MARRIAGE BLISS AT THE ORANGE COUNTY CLERK-RECORDER DEPARTMENT ON 2-22-22

This past Twos Day, better known as Tuesday, February 22, 2022 (2-22-22), Orange County Clerk-Recorder Hugh Nguyen offered extended hours at his offices ready to help couples tie the knot on a once-in-a-lifetime, palindrome and lucky date. Little did he know that he would be hosting one of the busiest days for marriage services in the department's history. The department issued a record-breaking 335 marriage licenses and performed a record setting 327 civil marriage ceremonies. These numbers shattered the previous record, set on Valentine's Day in 2014, of 310 marriage licenses issued and 266 civil marriage ceremonies performed.

"Couples were choosing 2-22-22 as their day to tie the knot since it is a once-in-a-lifetime date and many also believe it is a lucky date," said Clerk-Recorder Hugh Nguyen. "I knew we would be busy, but it also turned out to be a fun and romantic day for all! Not even a little rain stopped the couples from getting married on this unique day. I would like to thank my staff for all the hard work they put into making this day special for the couples." he added.

There were many things that made this past Twos Day special. This once-in-a-life time date is considered lucky in some cultures due to its all even numbers. In some Asian cultures, this date is considered an auspicious wedding date which refers to a favorable day for a couple to hold the wedding. It is believed that if you hold the wedding on such a day, you will enjoy a happy and harmonious marriage. It is also a palindromic date, meaning the date can be read the same way backwards and forward in the format mm-dd-yy. This unique date fell on a Tuesday, the second day of the week in many cultures around the world. This has prompted the media to call the day Twos Day.

This was also the second time the department offered candlelit ceremonies inside the courtroom located on the third floor of the Old Orange County Courthouse. This added a sense of allure for couples to choose this date to exchange their vows. Couples were treated to a backdrop of rich woods, an ornate judge's bench, period chandeliers, and high ceilings for their special night. Adding to the appeal, the courthouse has been featured in movies and television shows since 1915. It can be seen in the films *Frances, Catch Me If You Can*, and *Legally Blonde* to name a few.

CLERK-RECORDER IMPLEMENTS TECHNOLOGY TO HELP INCREASE EFFICIENCY AND IMPROVE CUSTOMER SERVICE EXPERIENCE AT THE DEPARTMENT'S NORTH COUNTY BRANCH OFFICE

Orange County Clerk-Recorder Hugh Nguyen has implemented Qtrac, a digital queue management software, at the department's North County Branch Office in Anaheim. The technology was implemented to help reduce lines, disperse waiting crowds and decrease wait times allowing staff to focus on helping customers and creating an efficient service experience for all customers. The technology has been in use at the department's office in Santa Ana and has already showed great results.

"I am always looking for ways to make visits to our office convenient and pleasant for our customers," Clerk-Recorder Hugh Nguyen said. "This technology has already improved service at our main office in Santa Ana and I am looking forward to seeing great results at our office in Anaheim."

Qtrac allows customers to check-in for service upon arriving at the office. Once they check-in, they are placed on a digital queue and receive a text message on their cell phone to confirm their place in line. When it is a customer's turn, they receive a text message letting them know where to proceed for service. Once a customer is served, they will receive a final text message allowing them to participate in a survey rating their service experience.

This technology allows the department to manage work loads more efficiently by providing live data to managers and supervisors allowing them to deploy resources when needed and during unexpected surges in demand for services. This also helps the department manage social distancing guidelines and restrictions to ensure the safety of customers and staff.

Feb. 2, 1848	Mexico ceded California to the United States in the Treaty of
	Guadalupe-Hidalgo.

	A flood caused about \$500,000 in damages (which would be \$9.7 million
Feb. 7, 1937	today) across Orange County. The rain stopped before total catastrophe
	ensued. 1938's flood would be worse.

Feb. 15, 1936 The Bowers Museum opened in Santa Ana.

Feb. 16, 1903 The golden poppy (*Eschscholtzia*) became California's official state flower.

Feb. 24, 1857 A group of German immigrants met in San Francisco to form the Los Angeles Vineyard Society, which later planned and founded Anaheim.
