CLERK-RECORDER DEPARTMENT PASSPORT SERVICES REMINDER

The Orange County Clerk-Recorder department currently offers passport services by appointment at two of our convenient locations: the County Service Center at 601 N. Ross Street, Santa Ana, CA and the North County branch office at 222 S. Harbor Blvd., Suite 110B, Anaheim, CA.

Our department is not only one of the fastest and most efficient local passport acceptance facilities, but we also have one of the lowest passport photo fees in the region. On March 9, 2022, Clerk-Recorder Hugh Nguyen lowered the passport photo fee from \$10 to \$7. This follows Clerk-Recorder Nguyen's first successful photo fee reduction from \$15 to \$10 in 2017. The passport acceptance process requires various official documents and different forms of payment. Please note, the Clerk-Recorder department is authorized to receive passport applications on behalf of the U.S. Department of State. Our office ensures everything is submitted correctly to avoid any delays. The U.S. Department of State is responsible for processing passport applications and issuing passports.

JULY IN O.C. HISTORY

July 5, 1887	Edward Amerige drives a stake into a mustard field at what would become the corner of Harbor Blvd and Commonwealth Ave., marking the birth of the townsite of Fullerton.
July 7, 1846	Commander John D. Sloat raises the American flag over Monterey, declaring California a U.S. possession.
July 10, 1845	Further immigration of U.S. citizens to California is forbidden by the Mexican government.
July 11, 1889	Orange Countians select Santa Ana as their county seat, and elect their first County Supervisors.
July 17, 1955	Disneyland is dedicated on a live national TV broadcast. Media and celebrities are allowed into the park for a preview day.
